Following guidelines from the Massachusetts Dental Society and the State of Massachusetts, we will be closing our office for routine dental care starting March 16 through April 7. We will be following state guidelines and these dates may change.

We will be available for dental emergencies which cannot wait until April to be seen. Please call our office at 978-562-6926 if you have a dental emergency.

Our office strictly follows state guidelines for sterilization and infection control, and we continue to maintain these standards for each patient. We are increasing the cleaning of our waiting room and common areas of the office and disinfecting multiple times each day.

We ask any patient who has been exposed or thinks they may have been exposed to the Coronavirus to stay home and not come to the office until cleared by their primary care doctor. Patients who have traveled internationally or patients with respiratory problems such as cough, shortness of breath or fever should seek medical help from their provider and reschedule their appointment at least three weeks into the future.
